

Facilitation course for CPRR instructors

Eligibility criteria

Recommendation from CPRR course:

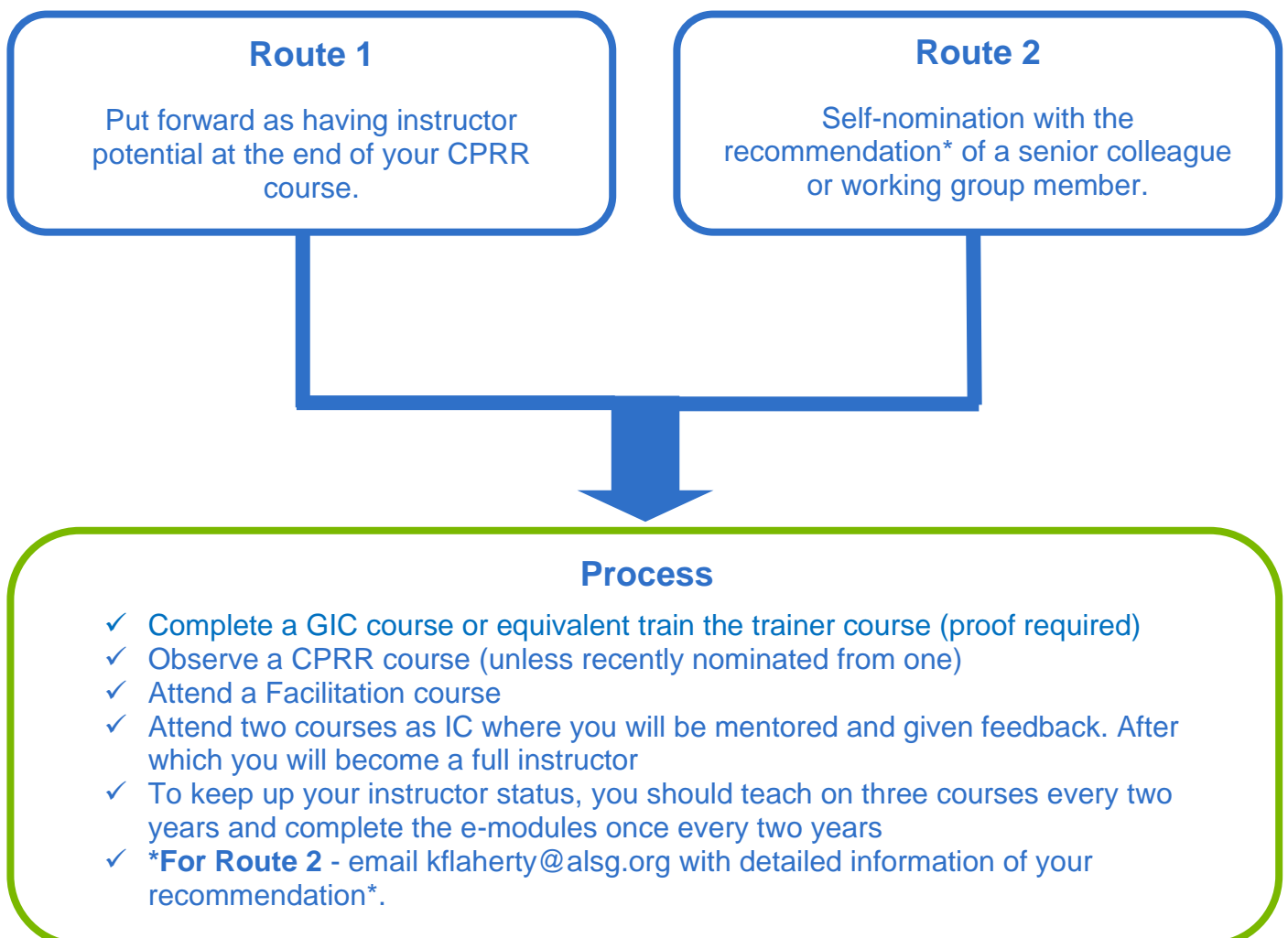
- Paediatric ST4 trainee or working on the Middle Grade rota
- ST4 or above in Paediatric Dentistry
- Paediatric Consultants / Associate Specialists
- Paediatric Advanced Nursing Practitioners working on the Middle Grade rota

Self-nomination:

- ST7 or above
- Named or Designated Safeguarding Nurses

Prerequisites: experience in child protection work, and level 3 training of CPiP / equivalent (e.g., greater than CPRR course)

There are two routes from which you can become a Child Protection: Recognition and Response Instructor (CPRR):



Route 1

Put forward as having instructor potential at the end of your CPRR course.

Route 2

Self-nomination with the recommendation* of a senior colleague or working group member.

Process

- ✓ Complete a GIC course or equivalent train the trainer course (proof required)
- ✓ Observe a CPRR course (unless recently nominated from one)
- ✓ Attend a Facilitation course
- ✓ Attend two courses as IC where you will be mentored and given feedback. After which you will become a full instructor
- ✓ To keep up your instructor status, you should teach on three courses every two years and complete the e-modules once every two years
