

Mike Davis Bursary Fund

The 'Mike Davis Bursary Fund' was launched in 2017 when Mike stepped down as ALSG's lead educator after a hugely successful 21 years in post. In honour of Mike's contribution to ALSG, this special fund was launched to give future ALSG instructors the opportunity to complete a GIC where they may not have the financial support to do so.

Mike has been involved with ALSG since 1996 when a chance meeting led to him getting involved in the life support community as an educator on the GIC, which he continued to do for 21 years. He has also been an educator with ATLS, ETC, IMPACT and the Child Protection Masterclass/Facilitation course in the UK and overseas.

ALSG would like to thank Mike for his steadfast support over those 21 years and we hope by having this Bursary Fund in his name, it will give our future instructors the opportunity Mike worked so hard to deliver on our courses.

Now open for applications!

The Bursary annually awards one funded GIC place to a potential ALSG instructor based on an application made before 31st January 2020. For applications made before before this date, one GIC place will be offered in the following 12 months. All applications will be assessed by an independent committee from ALSG including: Dr Mike Davis, Dr Kate Denning (Lead Educator, ALSG) and Professor Kevin Mackway-Jones (ALSG Chair of Trustees).

- A short summary CV; and

- Ongoing career intentions in CME
