

Professor Kevin Mackway-Jones



Kevin Mackway-Jones has been Chair of Trustees at ALSG since 2011 having been involved since its inception in 1990. A Consultant in Emergency Medicine at Manchester Royal Infirmary (MRI) since 1993, he trained at Balliol College, Oxford qualifying in 1981 and after house jobs proceeded to MRCP (1985) and FRCSEd (1987). He trained in Emergency Medicine in the North West and became a Fellow of the College of Emergency Medicine in 1993. As well as consulting at MRI and Royal Manchester Children's Hospital, Kevin Mackway-Jones is a Professor of Emergency Medicine at Manchester Metropolitan University and is Director of their Postgraduate Medicine provision.

Kevin was also Executive Medical Director of the North West Ambulance Service and Editor of the BMJ EMJ (Emergency Medicine Journal) where he

now acts as Honorary Advisor. He is Civilian Consultant Advisor to the British Army and Head of the North Western School of Emergency Medicine.

Kevin has interests in evidence-based medicine, medical education and has published widely in all of these areas, both in terms of books, research and journals. As well as being the overall Chair Kevin has chaired many of ALSG's working groups focusing on paediatrics, major incidents, triage and mental health.
